4. Record any important dates or numbers that appear in the cartoon.
5. Which of the objects are symbols? What do you think each symbol means?
6. List adjectives that describe the emotions portrayed in the cartoon.
7. Explain the message of the cartoon. What is the cartoonist's opinion about the topic portrayed in the cartoon?
8. What special interest groups would agree/disagree with the cartoon's message? Why?
9. Do you agree/disagree with the cartoonist's opinion? Why?
